#### A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

A reminder that the Lenten Prayer Service is next Sunday, March 3 at 9:40 in the cafeteria. Please join us! On March 10 we will have a box at the door for any Cart Sunday donations.

As we prepare for Lent, we focus on prayer, fasting, and giving alms. Changing habits is hard, and Lent is a perfect time of penitence to reflect on your life and make changes for the better. How might you as a family incorporate these three items into your lives? Maybe you increase your prayer time with your children to include morning prayer before they leave for school? It is important to attend Mass as a family to pray together. Instead of dropping off your child for PSR and going to 8:30 Mass without them, Lent would be a good time to change that habit and take them with you to 10:15, or another Mass time on the weekend. Your children are learning so much about their faith and they should be practicing it at Mass, too. Fasting doesn't just mean giving up food! You can fast from your favorite food or drink, but you could also fast from being too busy to spend time with those you love. You can fast for others by giving some of your free time to volunteer in your community or in your parish. Fast from noise! Instead of listening to the radio or your favorite podcast, spend that time in silence with the Lord. Giving alms is yet another practice of penitence during Lent. Instead of eating out one night during the week, eat at home together and donate the money you would have spent to a worthwhile charity. Give time to the Lord in Reconciliation. Take your children with you to one of the many Confession times available here at Church. No matter what you choose to do this Lent, share this time with your family!

Our last Pulse of the PSR meeting was great! We love hearing how we can make our program better for our families. You should find meeting minutes with this newsletter. To help us prepare for next year, we will be sending a family "letter of intent" on March 3 to determine how many families will be returning to PSR next year.
