Pastor's Desk



I used to watch a tv program called, "I (almost) Got Away With It." It features real-life stories of inmates in prison who managed to escape their confinement....for a while. They would come up with meticulous plans to make their escape, and then on the right day and at the right moment, make their escape. Sometimes they escaped alone; other times they escaped with other inmates.

But after watching a few episodes, you notice a couple of common themes emerge. For one thing, the escapees have ingenious plans for escape, but then no plans after that. As a result, if they make a successful escape, they become like drifters who move from town to town, state to state. Most likely, they are unable to find honest work or a steady place to live. But the other theme that almost always emerges is fear. The escapees are always looking over their shoulder, or wondering if others have discovered their true identity. In short, they live in a state of hyper-vigilance that verges on paranoia. And by the end of each episode, the escapees always wind up being caught. Sometimes it was days after their escape; sometimes it was many years after. But once they are finally captured, many of them will say the same thing. They'll say there was a sense of relief when they were captured. That's because they were tired of living on the lam. Their life of freedom wasn't all that free—not when they constantly suspected that someone was about to catch them.

Today begins the season of Advent. The readings for the season speak about vigilance, about keeping watch for the coming of Christ—both in his being born into the world, but also Jesus' coming at the end of the world. But when we speak of the "end of the world," we have to be careful. For the Christian, the end of the world is not something to be dreaded. It's not this terrifying ultimate destiny in which God's judgment comes crashing down on us like a hammer. Rather, the end of the world is really a new birth, a birth into the fullness of God's world, God's kingdom. It is a world to be welcomed and anticipated. It is the world in which we are meant to live, one of peace, justice and fullness of life. We could say that from the Catholic perspective, the end of the world is not the end of the world. It's not a bad outcome.

The Advent season is a season in which we are given special time to think about God, and our faith in relation to God. We are reminded to keep watch and pay attention. Do we live our faith waiting for the shoe to drop, feeling as though we are living life on the run, with God waiting to catch up to us? Do we put so much stress on the sin of our lives that we overlook the grace that is so much greater? Advent is the season of hope, and these days we could use the gift of hope more than ever. But our hope in God is not grounded in empty optimism. Rather, it's grounded on the past, and the love that God has already revealed to us. But that's not all. Our hope is also grounded in the future, that God's proven love in the past will continue into the future until all creation no longer can rebel against God's designs. In the mystery of the Eucharist, we remember that sacrificial love is not only a past event, but one that extends into our day. It forms the basis of our future hope....and our final destiny.

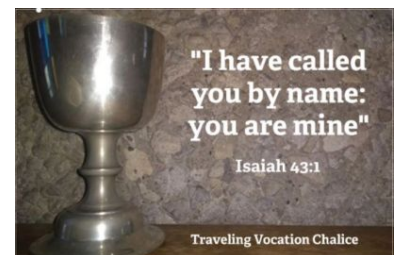

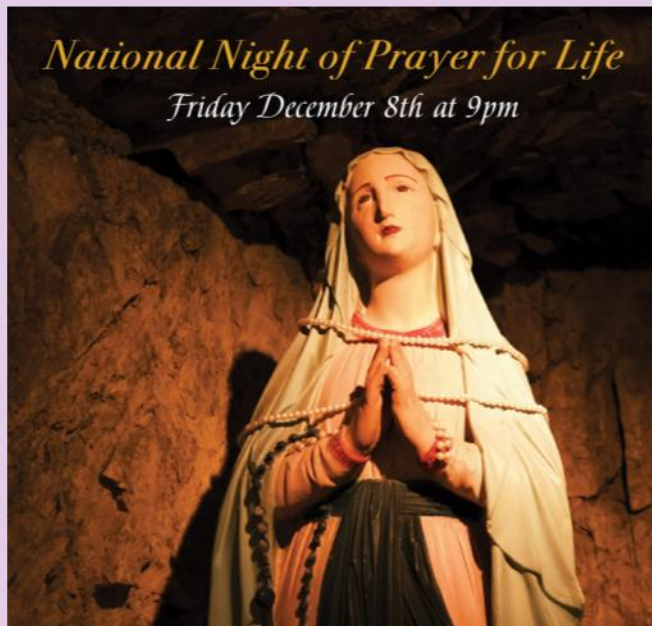

Rorate Mass

Saturday, December 16

6:30 AM

The Rorate Mass is a particular votive Mass in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary celebrated during Advent. The atmosphere of this Mass is different: it is meant to specifically express the expectant and prayerful waiting of Advent in a visual and experiential way. It is celebrated before first light and is entirely candle-lit (accounting for our early start time). The Mass gets its name from its entrance antiphon, which begins with the words “Rorate Caeli”, meaning “drop down, you heavens.” The antiphon in full is taken from the book of the prophet Isaiah:

*“Drop down, you heavens,
from above, and let the clouds
rain down the just one.”*

This quote encapsulates the prophetic expectation of the Messiah, fulfilled at the coming of Christ through Mary.



This is an opportunity to enter the Mass in (literally) a different light and a tradition that can help give shape to Advent, which, even within the Church, has gotten somewhat lost in the rush to celebrate Christmas. In short, there's no better use of your Saturday morning—please join us for this Advent Mass! Doughnut breakfast/social to follow in Loyola Hall.

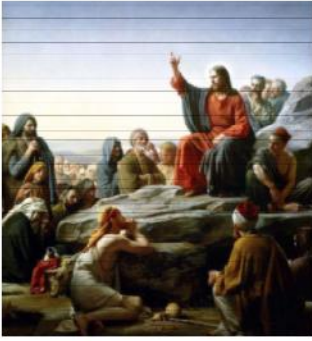

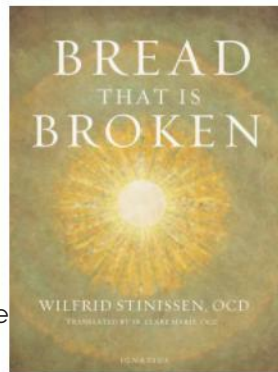

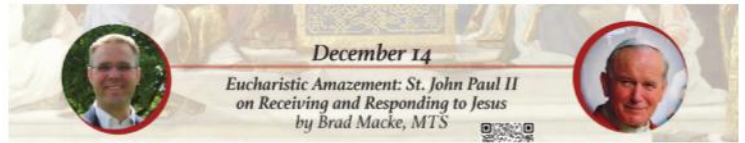

Catholic School Supporters May be Eligible for an Ohio Tax Credit Scholarship Granting Organizations (SGO)

A tax credit is more beneficial to our donors than a tax deduction. It means that donor pays up to \$1,500 less in Ohio State taxes.



The State of Ohio passed a bill that allows a tax credit for qualified donations to a certified SGO. Ohio taxpayers who donate to SGOs may be able to claim a dollar-for-dollar, non-refundable tax credit on their state income tax return for up to \$750 per donor (up to \$1,500 if married and filing jointly). Important: married couples would need to make their OWN \$750 contribution to claim the maximum amount. Separate acknowledgement letters will be provided for documentation of your gifts.

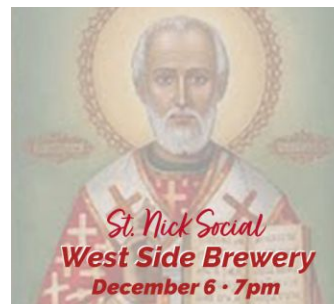
