The Archdiocese of Cincinnati recognizes the need to address child abuse, and attempts to do so through the Decree on Child Protection. The purpose of the Decree is two-fold. It is intended to prevent the abuse of children and adolescents and, to provide a system for handling incidents of abuse after they occur.

Prevention can best be achieved by the education of children, clerics, employees, parents and volunteers about the realities of abuse. The key elements of the system include a report to civil authorities, assessing theallegation, caring for the abused individual and his/her family, acting appropriately with regard to the accused person, and attending to the local church community.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a reflective-based religious formation that helps a child to further develop his/her relationship with God in a developmentally appropriate way. It is rooted in Sacred Scripture, the Liturgy and Prayer. Children meet in small groups along with a catechist within a prepared environment known as an atrium. Within the atrium, the 3-6 year olds are filled with wonder and awe as they joyfully encounter the Good Shepherd and discover his unconditional love and care. The atrium provides a space, based upon the educational philosophy of Maria Montessori, for children to pray, work, and contemplate the presence of God in their lives.
