APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS PASTORAL COUNCIL (PC) MEETING MINUTES:

- Brian Linneman made a motion to approve the May, 2026 PC meeting minutes. He was seconded by Dennis Wiwi. Motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Council member changes

- Mike introduced the new members in attendance and gave each one the opportunity to share a quick bio with the group. Colin Lang will be joining the group for the next meeting.
- A big thank you to the outgoing members – Mike Essen, Mikey Disbennett, Bridget Eichhold and Alan Gerken.

2. Mary Dadosky - Parish Office Update

- Mary reviewed all of the staff changes happening at the Parish office. Kim Abele has departed for a new position elsewhere and Beth Scholl has accepted the role of Directory of Evangelization.
- Summer office hours are 8-4:30 M-Th, 8-2 Fri and 10-1 on Saturday.
- Fr. Tran will be leaving St Ignatius to move onto his next assignment. His departure date is June 22nd. Fr. Thomas Dorn will be joining the parish on July 1.
- The Parish will celebrate Fr. Umberg's 35th anniversary of his ordination to the priesthood on Saturday June 6. All are encouraged to attend.
- The Parish is looking for ideas to help celebrate some upcoming happenings at and around St. Ignatius including a celebration to honor the Parish's 80th anniversary, the Feast of St Ignatius on July 31 and our country's 250th birthday. We are gathering details on a possible outing to a Reds game on June 25th. Further details to follow.
- Gallagher Bassett (our insurance carrier) will be on campus this summer to conduct its normal inspection of the grounds.

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- Updates to the front office of the Parish office are underway. These modifications to the copier room and the Behler meeting space are being completed by the maintenance department.
- In response to a follow up question from Jim Macke regarding Mary's last report to the PC, she responded as follows:
 - Elevator is currently being serviced.
 - Due to safety concerns, the Church bells are scheduled for service.
 - Boilers and chillers will now be inspected annually in an attempt to spread the cost of any necessary repairs.
 - Bleachers have been ordered and are expected to be delivered/installed sometime in late July-early August. This will be completed in time for the festival.

PASTOR'S REMARKS:

- The Behler meeting room update will help provide more space for the CGS program, the Parish's Montessori type religion instruction program for children.
- Mary Dadosky's position as Director of Administration and Human Resources came about as a result of the Beacons of Light project. At that time, this change in leadership led to staff changes and restructuring, along with a thorough review of the exempt vs nonexempt positions as the parish prepared for the conversion to the new automated payroll package.
- Fr. Dorn is planning to work with the Youth of the parish and OCIA.
- 15 new servers have been fully trained and seem happy with their new assignments.
- Fr. thanked Mike Essen for his dependable service to the PC as he steps down from the president role.
