**PANDEMIC
RESPONSE**

LEVEL 1

This level will be for a normal all school re-opening with no restrictions. All students and staff return for five days of instruction and on a regular daily school schedule.

LEVEL 2

This level is a return to school for all students and staff for five days. Restrictions will be implemented that could impact the school daily schedule, calendar, and health and safety protocols.

LEVEL 3

Level 3 would be a hybrid of in person classes and remote learning. Students with last names beginning with A-K would attend school face to face on Monday and Tuesday. Students with last names beginning with L-Z will attend school face to face on Thursday and Friday. All lessons would be remote learning on Wednesday.

LEVEL 4

All learning will be conducted remotely. School building is closed and all activities are canceled.

SCHEDULE

Students and staff will begin the school year in August on campus five days a week. Students and staff will follow the regular daily schedule.

MASS AND LARGE GATHERINGS

School Masses will follow the protocols in place for the parish. Assemblies and large gatherings are limited or canceled.

TEMPERATURE SCREENING

Parents should conduct a student wellness check including temperature prior to placing a child on the bus or dropping off at school. Students with a temperature over 100 degrees should stay home. Students and staff will be required to get a temperature check as they arrive at school each day.

VISITORS & VOLUNTEERS

Volunteering in the school will be limited but possible. Parents picking up sick children should come to the front office and the office staff will bring your child to you. It is recommended that visitors wear a mask.

SOCIAL DISTANCING / HEALTH

Wearing masks will be optional. When possible, classroom seating will be arranged to limit face-to-face contact and to maximize social distancing. Student travel in the hallways will be organized to limit exposure.

Any student or staff member with a fever over 100 degrees must be fever free for 24 hours, without medication, before returning to school.

Students and staff will use the cafeteria.

SCHOOL NURSE

The school nurse will be working from the clinic. Students with a cough and/or fever must wear a mask until a parent comes to pick them up. The same students will be placed in a isolation room until picked up. Parents picking up sick children should come to the front office.

COVID-19 DIAGNOSIS

Any staff member or student that has been diagnosed or exposed to Covid-19 must remain at home for at least 14 days. This is subject to change per the local health department.

CLEANING & DISINFECTING

Enhanced cleaning protocols have been established with a focus on high touch surfaces. Students and staff will participate in repeated handwashing or sanitizing during the day. Good hygiene and safety practices will be reviewed with students.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

Arrival and dismissal from school will occur as normal.

SCHEDULE

Students and staff will begin the 2020-2021 school year in August on campus five days a week. Students and staff will follow the regular daily schedule. Restrictions will be implemented. Students will stay in their homerooms for the entire day with teachers rotating to those classrooms.

MASS AND LARGE GATHERINGS

School Masses will follow the protocols in place for the parish. Assemblies, field trips, and large gatherings are canceled.

TEMPERATURE SCREENING

Parents should conduct a student wellness check including their temperature prior to placing a child on the bus or dropping off at school. Students with a temp of over 100 degrees should stay home. Students and staff will be required to get a temperature check as they arrive at school each day.

VISITORS & VOLUNTEERS

Volunteering in the school will be suspended. Visitors to the building will be permitted to the Front Office during the school day.

Parents picking up sick children should come to the front office and the office staff will bring your child to you.

SOCIAL DISTANCING / HEALTH

Wearing masks will be mandatory for the entire day in grades 1-8 with scheduled mask breaks as age appropriate. Facemasks should be worn when entering and exiting the building.

Classroom seating will be arranged to limit face-to-face contact and to maximize social distancing.

Any student or staff member with a fever over 100 degrees must be fever free for 24 hours. Anyone with Covid-19 symptoms would need to check with their doctor before returning to school.

Students and staff will eat lunch in their homerooms each day.

Students will keep all school supplies and books in a personal backpack - this is for all grades.

Students with last names between L-Z will attend school on Thursday and Fridays. All students attend remotely on Wednesdays.

MASS AND LARGE GATHERINGS

School Masses will follow the protocols in place for the parish. Assemblies, field trips, and large gatherings are canceled.

TEMPERATURE SCREENING

Parents should conduct a student wellness check including their temperature prior to placing a child on the bus or dropping off at school. Students with a temp of over 100 degrees should stay home. Students and staff will be required to get a temperature check as they arrive at school each day.

VISITORS & VOLUNTEERS

Volunteering in the school will be suspended. Visitors to the building will be permitted to the Front Office during the school day. Parents picking up sick children should come to the front office and the office staff will bring your child to you.

SOCIAL DISTANCING / HEALTH

Wearing masks will be encouraged for the entire day. Facemasks will be worn when out of the classroom, entering, and exiting the building.

Classroom seating will be arranged with 6 feet of social distancing between students.

Any student or staff member with a fever over 100 degrees must be fever free for 24 hours. Anyone with Covid-19 symptoms would need to check with their doctor before returning to school.

Students and staff will eat lunch in their homerooms each day.

Students will keep all school supplies and books in a personal backpack - this is for all grades.

SCHEDULE

Students will participate in remote learning from home. Regular grading practices will be used and participation in live Zoom lessons will be required.

Attendance will be taken. If a child must miss the live lesson, parents should contact the teacher. Students and parents should check Google Classroom on a regular basis for live sessions and assignments. Scheduled days off could be eliminated.

MASS & LARGE GATHERINGS

All school events will be cancelled.

VISITORS & VOLUNTEERS

Access to the building will be limited to staff. Pick up and drop off of supplies will be coordinated for parents only.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Wearing masks will be mandatory when entering the building.
